"THE WORD EPIPHANY"

The word *epiphany* was used in Greek religion to indicate the appearance or manifestation of a god or goddess in human form along with the suggestion that the person or persons who had the epiphany would be delivered from danger and/or their enemies defeated. *Theophany* is a less frequently used word meaning the same thing. In the New Testa-

ment *epiphany* is used to refer to both the first and the final comings of Jesus *(Titus 2:11, 13)*. The word then came to be used of the miracles of Jesus as manifesting divine power.

"DIFFERENCE IN WEST & EAST"

Nowadays in the West the feast goes by the name Epiphany and celebrates the visit of the Magi and while in the East it is called Theophany and celebrates the appearance of God at the Baptism of Jesus.

"EPIPHANY"

This icon of the Epiphany retakes common elements from the representation of the Epiphany in the iconographical tradition. The Trinitarian element is thus represented: the Father by the chirophany (the appearance of the hand), symbol of the Creator and his voice. He is seen by His incarnate Son, baptized in the Jordan by the Forerunner. The Holy Spirit, in the form of a dove, descends from the heights and rests on the head of the Son. The angels hasten to carry towels to dry the Ember who has been baptized, symbolized by the flame coming out from the water. This is particular to the Syro-Maronite tradition. The fire and the water are the image of the divinity united to humanity through the person of the incarnate Son of God in the perfection of his two natures..

" SAINT ANTHONY THE GREAT "

was the first Christian to live a coenobitic consecrated life of solitude. As a hermit in the desert he lived a long and saintly life that influenced countless people both in his time and for generations thereafter, even to this day. Many of his ideas are still used to this day by modern monks and nuns nowadays. His life had a tremendous impact on the history of early Christianity, which is the basic history of all Christian churches all over the world. Most of what we know about St. Anthony comes from the writings of Saint Athanasius the Apostolic, a disciple and close friend of St. Anthony's, who wrote the story of his life.
