We all go through moments of "desolation," "darkness, in which things seem to losing their meaning, but it is precisely at these moments that Christians must persevere to reach the promise of the Lord, without giving up or looking at back.

The Christian life is not a carnival, it is not a feast and a continuous joy; the Christian life is made of beautiful moments and difficult moments. Both for the internal persecution and for the inner state of the soul, the author of the Letter to the Hebrews declares: "Endurance is necessary for you to fulfill the will of God and thus obtain the fulfillment of the

promises.

In his catechesis, Pope Francis focuses on two elements: memory and hope, a recipe against desolation. Like the apostle, he affirms that we must first remember the beautiful moments, the days of joy during his encounter with Christ, the times of love. Then in a second time, keep hope for what has been promised. This is how life is made, said the Holy Father, who calls to resist in bad times.

Our fathers, the priests, who preceded us to eternity continue their celebration there and preach the Bibles upon the altar of the luminous world, surrounded by worshipping angels. All this happens in an eschatological scene, presenting the Powerful One with the two eternal suppliants, the holy Virgin and the Forerunner, surrounded by a crowd of saints and angels who carry trumpets and scales. $|\vec{y}_{ij}| \rightarrow \infty$



<u>The Gospel</u> wants to create in us an attitude of waiting and welcoming of <u>Christ. This expectation does not focus on a more or less distant future</u> that we cannot know, but rather it turns us towards the present. The return of Christ is not like a great light that would put the present world in the shadow, but on the contrary, it illuminates our present life! The present does not cut us off from the one who comes. We are already bound to Christ by doing his will: to serve those whom he has entrusted to us. Jesus became servant of all; he asks us to really serve in our turn. Far from wanting to lead us into a sterile and paralyzing fear, his words recall how great is the trust that God gives to men, this unreserved trust which, if not forgotten, arouses this response of the Christian: to imitate Christ himself-even. "Lord, that's the happiness we want! May your Holy Spirit assist us to work in fidelity and prudence to what you expect from us in our families, our workplaces, our communities, according to the call of you that we have recognized and to which we have chosen to respond."
