"The Healing of the Leper Sunday"

"الأحد الثاني من زمن الصوم: آية شفاء الأبرص"

Through the intercession of the Virgin Mary, Mother of God, Jesus fulfills his first miracle. Water, a natural element, simple and used daily to hydrate and purify itself, is transformed into

wine, a composite element, the result of pressed bunches of grapes and a long fermentation. This miraculous transformation constitutes the dynamic image of the authentic approach that the faithful Christian will have to perform during this important time of Lent.

This day is the glorious gateway to a path of Christ-like divinization of excellence, similar

to the transformation of water into a good wine, thanks to the divine love of Jesus for our salvation. It is a return to the original purity of Adam and Eve before the original sin, found by grace in the sacrament of Baptism. "In truth I tell you, unless you change and become like little children you will never enter the kingdom of Heaven." (Mt 18: 3)

Now, let us listen to the cry of our Lord Jesus Christ, he challenges us to begin this path out of the ordinary in our daily lives. This high season of Lent is dedicated to preparation for the Easter wedding where we will taste the true wine of divine happiness, victory over death and the glorious life in the heart of the love and mercy of the Sacred Heart of the Risen Christ.

This Icon of the Healing of the Leper, like the following icons of healing, is drawn on a luminous background that highlights the Holy City and its walls. The Lord with some of the Apostles, among them Peter, blesses the leper, who is kneeling in front of him, and heals and purifies him. This icon is similar to those inspired from healings and miracles in Vaticanus Syriacus 559 and British Library 7170.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Observing Lent: Lent, or "As-Sawm" in Arabic, is the period of 40 days (some churches count Sundays, others do not) before the Easter Feast. Traditionally, Lent is a period of fasting, prayer and penitence that culminates in Holy Week with the commemoration of Jesus Christ's arrest, trial, crucifixion, burial and resurrection. The 40 days are symbolic of the time that Jesus spent in the desert when he was tested by the Devil. Lent is a time for "reconsidering disciple—ship and examining life and obedience to God."

Despite their concurrence, the Great Lent of the Maronite Church is not the same as the Lent of the Roman Catholic Church, a fact that reflects the unique historical position of this community of Catholics in the East. The Church, which is western by virtue of its longstanding communion with Rome, is also eastern in that it uses an eastern rite and Syriac liturgy, in addition to observing a more or less orthodox Lent. Maronites, unlike Roman Catholics, do count the Sundays in Lent as part of the 40 days, which means that the liturgical season begins two days earlier and ends a full week earlier, marking off Holy Week as a separate liturgical period. Fasting, however, lasts

ly Week as a separate liturgical period. Fasting, however, lasts through Holy Week to Easter, adding up to a total of eight weeks.
