Love for sinners, the unfailing sign of the Father. In his Encyclical on the Mercy of God, Pope John Paul II explains how Christ, in this Gospel text, begins to reveal the mystery of man by revealing the Father: With these facts and words, Christ makes the Father present among men.

It is highly significant that these men are above all the poor, who have no means of subsistence, those deprived of freedom, the blind who do not see the beauty of creation, those who live in affliction of the heart or suffer because of social injustice, and finally sinners. It is especially with regard to these men that the Messiah becomes a particularly readable sign of the fact that God is love; he becomes a sign of the Father. In this visible sign, men of our time, like those of that time, can also see the Father."

"Transfiguration of the Lord Jesus "August 6th

The purpose of Christ's transfiguration in at least part of his heavenly glory was certainly to enable the "inner circle" of his closest disciples to better understand him. Jesus radically changed his appearance, so that his disciples could contemplate his glory. The disciples, who until now only knew him in his human form, became more aware of Christ's divinity, even though they still did not fully understand it. It brought them the comfort they needed after hearing the terrible news of his imminent death.



Symbolically, the appearance of Moses and Elijah represents the Law and the Prophets. God's voice from heaven says,

"Listen to him!" clearly shows that the Law and the Prophets must now give way to Jesus, the new and living path that replaces the old, the fulfillment of the Law and the innumerable prophecies of the Old Testament. Moreover, his glorified form reveals to them a glimpse of his future glorification and his induction as King of kings and Lord of lords.

The disciples never forgot what happened that day on the mountain and this was certainly the intention of Jesus. John wrote in his Gospel: "We have contemplated his glory, a glory like that of the only-begotten Son who came from the Father" (John 1:14). Peter also wrote on this subject: Indeed, it is not by following cleverly conceived fables that we have made known to you the powerful coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but only after seeing his majesty with our own eyes. Yes, he
